

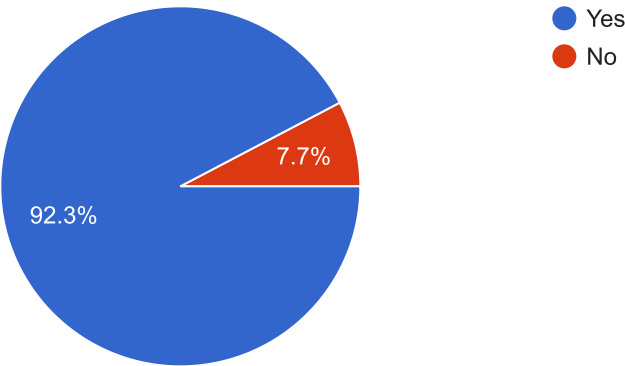

Because tipping should be more personal and credit seems more like just paying people what they should be paid to begin with,

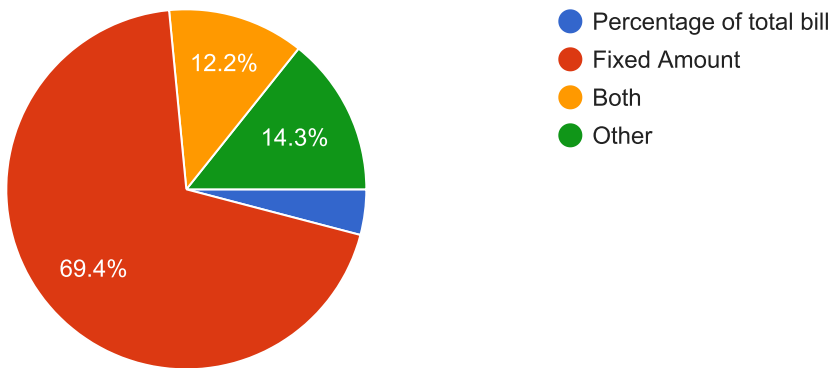
suspicion that a non cash tip is not going to reach the person I tipped

If you answered "Percentage of total bill" to the previous question, what percentage do you typically use?

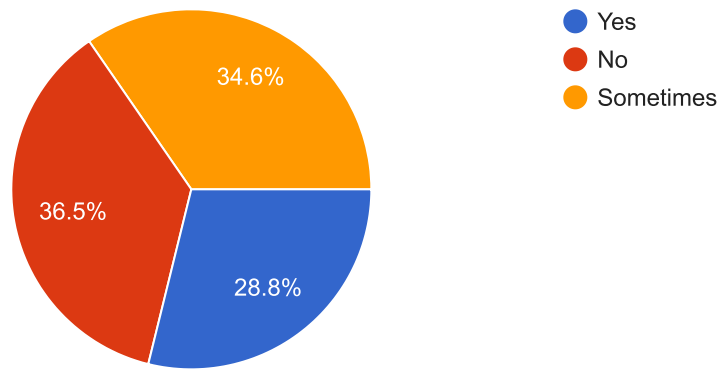

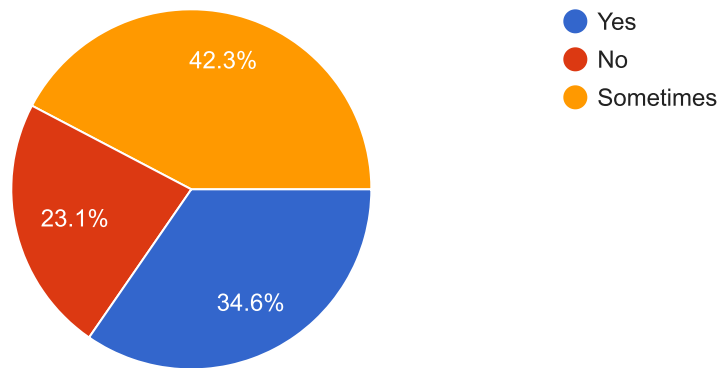
If you answered "No" to the previous question, when do you typically use housekeeping services?

- once on a ten day to see how the room was cleaned

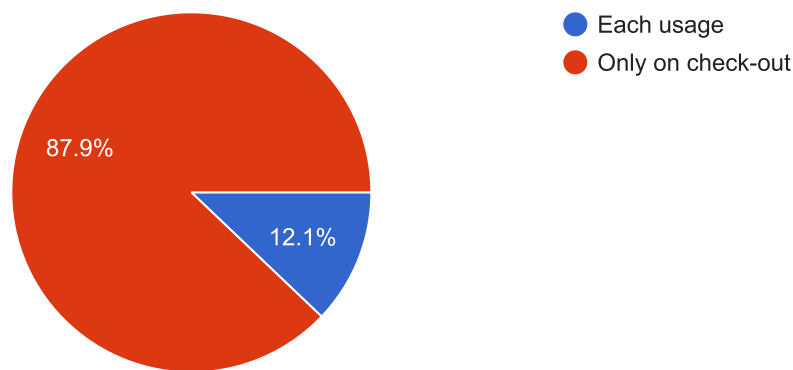
As a traveler, do you tip housekeeping?
